Vladimir Putin and the leaders of the Asia-Pacific region countries to take part in the EEF plenary session ‘The Russian Far East: Expanding the Range of Possibilities’

Together with the Russian President, the President of China Xi Jinping, the President of Mongolia Khaltmaagiin Battulga, the Prime Minister of Japan Shinzō Abe, and the Prime Minister of the Republic of Korea Lee Nak-yeon will address the event. (Izvestia)

Resolution of the Government of the Russian Federation signed to expand the Nadezhdinskaya Advanced special economic zone in Primorye Territory.

Seven new land lots are included into the ASEZ boundaries. The corresponding document was signed on 4 September by Dmitry Medvedev, Chairman of the Government of the Russian Federation. (Izvestia)

Irina Yarovaya suggested establishing comprehensive measures to support and develop tourism in the Russian Far East.

Vice-Speaker of the State Duma proposes to develop a list of routes for passenger ships and provide for the possibility of tourist electronic visas to be issued for visitors of several Far East regions. (FederalPress)
