A forecast for the development of the global economy will be presented at the EEF 2018. Member of the Global Energy Prize International Award Committee and international expert on energy and climate change Rae Kwon Chung will speak at the EEF Youth Platform as part of the Energy of Knowledge programme with the World Energy Outlook for 2030 report. A charity auction to support biodiversity conservation programmes will be held as part of the EEF. Lots for the auction have traditionally been provided by the heads of the regions of the Far Eastern Federal District, nature reserves and national parks of the Far East, non-profit organizations, and prominent Russian culture, art, and sport figures. A project to build a bridge to Yelena Island in Vladivostok should take about five years. The first stage of the project will involve the construction of a 5.5-km road and two bridges – one to Yelena Island and another over a canal. The project will cost RUB 19 billion. (Primpress.ru)
