First investment projects of the Far East Fish Processing Cluster will be presented at the Eastern Economic Forum. The volume of financing at the expense of private investments will come to RUB 20.8 bn.

Any private investment project in Russian Far East may get administrative support and official participant status under the programme “Socioeconomic Development of Russian Far East and the Baikal Region up to 2025”. A resolution on amending the investment project selection and support methodology has been signed by Dmitry Medvedev.
