Primorye-based Sumotori will sign three agreements with Chinese investors at the EEF. The agreements were reached during the visit by an official delegation of Primorsky Region to the Chinese province of Jilin.

Representatives of a refinery in the Amur Region plan to agree with potential suppliers of raw materials at the Eastern Economic Forum. The refinery should start production in 2019.
