Vladimir Putin to hold talks with Mongolian President Khaltmaa Battulga on EEF sidelines. The Russian president reached an agreement with the Mongolian leader to hold talks during a working visit in Budapest. (RIA News)

Russia and Singapore planning to intensify cooperation as part of international events, including EEF. This was reported during a meeting between Adviser to the Russian President Anton Kobaykov and Ambassador of the Republic of Singapore to the Russian Federation Lim Kheng Hua. (TASS)

Primorye Territory planning to sign 40 agreements for RUB 200 billion at EEF. The biggest agreement will be for the project to build the Primorye 1 and Primorye 2 international transport corridors, which is to be implemented jointly with the Chinese construction corporation Guanda. (TASS)

Slavtrans Service to present project for Far Eastern agro-logistical hub in Primorye Territory at EEF. The hub will include the largest refrigerator warehouse complex in the Far East with capacity for some 70,000 tonnes and a container terminal with access to port and railway infrastructure. Investment will amount to at least RUB 10 billion. (Interfax)

Agreement to finance Far East Development and High Technologies Fund to be signed on sidelines of EEF 2017. The fund will provide loan-based funding to Far Eastern companies that are developing promising technologies and finance projects involving the transfer of technologies from abroad as well as the expansion and modernization of manufacturing of technological products. The fund will have a target size of RUB 10 billion (Komsomolskaya Pravda)

Vladivostok fishing port to build refrigeration complex to store 40,000 tonnes of fish. Total investment in the project will amount to RUB 1 billion, and around 100 jobs will be created. (TASS)

Far East Development Fund signs agreements on the Free Port of Vladivostok resident status with seven major Russian and foreign investment companies from 18–24 August 2017. The investment projects include the establishment of an agricultural complex, the construction of residential buildings, and the opening of a Harley-Davidson dealership centre. (Primorskaya Gazeta)

Resident certificates granted to 35 companies in Khabarovsk Territory Advanced Special Economic Zone with total investment of more than RUB 41 billion. Eleven of them have already launched production, investing over RUB 5 billion and creating more than 650 new jobs, Khabarovsk Territory Governor Vyacheslav Shport said. (Vostok-Media Information Agency)

The ‘Far Eastern hectare’ registration system will be modernized by the end of 2017, the Ministry for the Development of the Russian Far East press service said. The first priority is to provide the opportunity to exchange data electronically between the authorities and the Federal Service for State Registration, Cadastre and Cartography as part of the InFarEast.RF information system. (RIA News)
